


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Move the intersection of Holiday Ave. to the West of its present location to provide more efficient operating space away from the I-75 South bound ramps. Cul-de-sac the existing road.

COMMENTS

Two alternates have been proposed by Carter-Burgess (formerly DWA). One (Alt 1) would put the new road to the front of the Chamber of Commerce the other (Alt 2) to the back. The front alternate would impact the Chambers parking and would only move the road about 110' away from I-75 but aligns with W. Bridge Rd. The back alternate is a tough build due the grade and its impacts to the live stream/shoals but better achieves the separation from the interstate ramps.
