

## 2015 SPLOST Project List

### Priority 1

To be funded immediately from bond proceeds

1. Digital Emergency Response Communications System/Mobile CAD System for public safety personnel: \$12 million
2. Library building and technology improvements: \$500,000
3. Two ladder trucks — Whitfield County Fire Department (WCFD): \$2.3 million
4. Four pumper fire engines — WCFD: \$1.6 million
5. Turnout/breathing gear — WCFD: \$500,000
6. Two Class A Pumper Trucks and a Mobile Air & Light Vehicle — Dalton Fire Department (DFD): \$1.6 million
7. Lakeshore Park improvements: \$2.2 million
8. Tunnel Hill depot restoration (\$600,000) and sewer expansion (\$100,000)
9. Varnell
  - A. Police cars: \$150,000
  - B. Maintenance truck: \$30,000
  - C. Maintenance building: \$135,000
  - Subtotal: \$315,000
10. Cohutta
  - A. Police cars: \$150,000
  - B. Repairs to Medical Rescue Unit: \$20,000
  - C. Renovations to walking track, City Hall: \$80,000
  - D. Sewer Improvements: \$235,000
  - Subtotal: \$485,000
11. Rocky Face bike park: \$150,000
12. Edwards Park gymnasium and improvements: \$2 million
13. Land acquisition for new recreation park in south: \$1.5 million
14. Dawnville Park rehabilitation and improvements: \$350,000
15. Pleasant Grove Park rehabilitation and improvements: \$300,000
16. Westside Park/Miracle Field multi-use trail: \$100,000

## **Priority 2**

To be funded in this order of priority as funds are collected

1. Haig Mill public recreation project: \$5 million
  2. Sheriff vehicles: \$2 million
  3. Dalton Police Department vehicles: \$1.6 million
  4. Road projects (funded pro-rata within this item)
    - A. 3.7 Highway 201 straightening (roads, streets and bridges): \$6.5 million
    - B. Bridge/culvert repair (county) (roads, streets and bridges): \$2 million
    - C. Road paving (county) (roads, streets and bridges): \$6.5 million
    - D. Street repaving, bridge repair, stormwater control (Dalton): \$10 million
  5. New fire station on or near Cohutta-Varnell Road (WCFD): \$1.4 million
- Total: \$61.6 million
