Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Crossen to change the date of the first initial Committee meeting to August. The motion was approved 3-0, with Commissioners Crossen, Jones, and Robbins in agreement.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to change the end date of the Committee to when the BOC approves the SPLOST resolution or whenever the Committee's work is completed, whichever comes first. **The motion was approved 3-0, with Commissioners Crossen, Jones, and Robbins in agreement.**
