1. Joint Resolution with the Cities of Dalton, Tunnel Hill, Varnell and Town of Cohutta - Order to Mitigate the Spread of COVID-19: Motion was made by Commissioner Brooker and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to approve the joint resolution declaring a state of emergency in the Cities of Dalton, Tunnel Hill, Varnell, and the Town of Cohutta in order to mitigate the spread of Covid -19 by limiting all voluntary social gatherings, dine-in restaurant services, and exposure at nursing and retirement homes, and providing flexibility regarding the sale of alcohol for off premises use, and for other purposes. The following limitations are consistent with guidelines recommended by the President of the United States and will be implemented countywide as of 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2020 and shall expire on their own terms at midnight on April 13, 2020, unless extended by further action of the applicable governing authorities. The motion was approved 5-0, with Chairman Laughter and Commissioners Crossen, Jones, Robbins and Brooker in agreement.
