- Intergovernmental Agreement for Sewer Extension with/Dalton Utilities: Motion was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Jones to enter into an agreement for up to \$1.2M for the Sanitary Sewer Extension-Cleveland Hwy/Strain Rd. for sewer infrastructure and to provide sewer capacity. - 2. 2023 Budget Adoption: Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Staten to adopt the 2023 resolution of the operating budget for Whitfield County for \$53 million in revenues and expenditures.
