## 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan, Kick-off Meeting

### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND COMMENTS SOUGHT FOR LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The Greater Dalton Metropolitan Planning Organization will be holding the first in a series of public involvement meetings next Thursday, November 14, 2013 at the County Courthouse to gather citizen and stakeholder recommendations on future transportation needs for our area. This meeting will be held at the Whitfield County Courthouse. A Spanish translator will be present.

The public is encouraged to come and provide ideas and suggestions in the development of the LRTP which is a 40 year out vision for our community relating to transportation needs including roads, bridges, rail, airport, public transit, bike and pedestrian paths and facilities, traffic signals, freight and other transportation categories. As well as safety, marginalized population challenges and traffic flow issues, we seek input on transportation initiatives that will encourage regional competitiveness and sustainable transportation systems in both the short and long term.

Turn left on Thornton Avenue and continue straight for approximately 1 mile - the courthouse is a large brick structure on the corner of Thornton Avenue and West Crawford Street.

**From Atlanta:** I-75 North to exit 333 (Walnut Avenue). Turn right at the top of the ramp. Continue on Walnut Avenue for approximately two miles to the intersection of Thornton Avenue. Turn left on Thornton Avenue and continue straight for approximately 1 mile - the courthouse is a large brick structure on the corner of Thornton Avenue and West Crawford Street.
