



### **Basketball All- Star Coach Selection**

The Basketball Executive Committee and the Recreation Department will comprise a list of all-star coaches. A ballot will be completed and every coach in that particular league will select two coaches, a first choice then a second. The ballots will be tallied by the recreation department and the results will be available for informational purposes at the All-Star Coach Selection meeting which will be held on Wednesday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.

***This meeting will be for the Executive Committee.***

The coach must be NYSCA Certified in order to even be considered to coach an All-Star team.

**If a coach does not turn in a ballot he or she will not be considered for an All-Star Coach if they qualify.**

### **Selecting the Basketball All-Star Teams: (Adopted 2009 Basketball Season)**

- Player Nomination Form to be turned in by Wednesday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 by 5:00 p.m. **(Note: If a coach does not turn in the Player Nomination Form then the players from that team will not qualify to participate in All-Stars if chosen).**
- Each coach in the league will nominate players from his or her team and send it to the recreation department prior to the all star selection meeting.
- All Head Coaches will meet and vote on **Sunday, January 30<sup>th</sup>** with Mite 9-10 Girls at 2:00; Mite 9-10 Boys at 2:45, Midget 11-12 Girls at 3:30 then Midget 11-12 Boys will meet at 4:00.
- At the all star player selection meeting, coaches will need to vote for a minimum of 16 players and no more than 20 players in Round 1. A coach cannot vote for any of his or her players in Round 1. Votes will immediately be counted by parks and rec.
- Coaches will need to vote for a minimum of 16 players and no more than 20 players in Round 2. Coaches can vote for players that are on his or her team in Round 2. Votes will be combined from both rounds and the top 16 players with votes will be placed on the all star teams.
- The head coaches will have the opportunity to select the final two slots on each team if he or she chooses to do so. It is recommended that the last two slots be filled with the players who finished 17<sup>th</sup> through 20<sup>th</sup> in the voting.
- No all star team will have more than three players represented from any regular season team. However, the second team may have an additional one to two players from any regular season team.
