IN THE MAGISTRATE COURT OF WHITFIELD COUNTY PROCEDURES FOR FILING GARNISHMENTS

- 1. You <u>must</u> have a judgment not to exceed \$15,000.00 against an individual or an entity before you file an Affidavit of Garnishment <u>and</u> the Garnishee <u>must</u> be located in WHITFIELD County.
- 2. Once you have obtained a judgment against the defendant, you must decide which type of garnishment to file:

 Affidavit of Continuing Garnishment for wages: may be filed only if an Employer/Employee relationship exists between the garnishee and the defendant.

Affidavit of Garnishment on a Financial Institution

Please choose the correct affidavit and summons pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 18-4-7(d). If the Plaintiff chooses the incorrect forms, the garnishment **shall** be invalid and the garnishee shall be released of all liability.

- 3. The costs of filing a garnishment in this Court is \$97.00. This includes all filing fees and service of the garnishment on the Garnishee.
- 4. You will need the following forms, with an additional copy for service, to file with the Court:
 - 1. Affidavit of Garnishment (The Affidavit of Garnishment must be notarized.)
 - 2. Summons of Garnishment
 - 3. Attachment of Summons
 - 4. Notice to Defendant of Right against Garnishment of Money, Including Wages and Other Property
 - 5. Defendant's Claim Form

The Court will retain all originals and serve the garnishee with the service copy. You will need to make a copy of all forms to serve on the Defendant as required in O.C.G.A. § 18-4-8(b). Please visit our website, http://www.whitfieldcountyga.com/mc/magcourt.htm or speak with a Deputy Clerk to obtain forms.

- 5. The total amount of the garnishment can include the amounts that you were awarded in your judgment, any interest and court costs you may be entitled. This amount cannot exceed \$15,000.00; (**This does not include cost of garnishment**.)
- 6. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 18-4-8(b), the Plaintiff <u>must</u> serve the Defendant, **not more than three (3) days of the service to the garnishee**, by regular **AND** certified mail with a copy of the <u>Affidavit of Garnishment</u>, the <u>Summons of Garnishment</u>, and the <u>Notice to Defendant of Rights</u> Against Garnishment of Money, Including Wages and Other Property and <u>Defendant's Claim Form</u>. If the <u>Defendant</u> is not served within this time period the garnishment may be dismissed. If the <u>Defendant</u> is a resident of WHITFIELD County and you want our Constables to serve him/her with his/her copy of the garnishment, please add an additional \$50.00 to the cost.
- 7. Please file a Certificate of Service with appropriate service checked on document, along with all required documents with the Court. The <u>Court will not disburse any funds until the Certificate of Service is received</u>. Plaintiff's obligation to provide notice of the garnishment to the Defendant is governed by O.C.G.A. § 18-4-8. Please read this code section if you are unfamiliar with garnishment law regarding notice to the Defendant.
- 8. If the Court receives funds from the Garnishee, the funds will be disbursed according to the law in a timely manner. The Court must receive documentation that the Defendant has been served with the garnishment before any funds will be disbursed.
